

All Saints Episcopal of Huntington

The Church, originally located in Huntington of Putnam County, was built in 1891 to serve the area's English immigrants. Many of them returned to England after the citrus crops ruined in 1894-95 freezes. Attendance continued to decline; and, in 1943, decision was made to disassemble the Church and move it to Gilmore st in Jacksonville as part of St Stephens. After the splitting of the neighborhood by I-10, the Church was moved in 1971 to current location on Normandy Blvd. At some point in its history, its name was changed to **Church of the Nativity**..
