

Grace Episcopal Church of Port Orange

Bishop Young had at least twice visited the Port Orange Community during his many travels throughout Florida and Cuba (1, p52). And the nearby community of Daytona had erected St Mary's in 1883. Bishop Weed initially continued support for the Carpenter Gothic style, though by 1894 he exclaimed in reference to All Saints in Jacksonville that "the architect ... has given us some relief from the faint imitation of gothic architecture" (2,p178). But, in the meantime, the Port Orange community had erected their church in 1893. Built out of cedar and heart pine, the two Tiffany windows were added around the turn of the Century (3)
